Read through your essay. Using different colors, highlight:

- The names of authors/critics/artists you discuss, and the titles of works you discuss.
- Passages in which you directly quote another writer, or closely summarize their work.
- Keywords or ideas that you bring to the discussion.

Drawing on the terms you've highlighted, draft *three* possible titles for your essay:

- *Straightforward*: Describe your project. Make sure you include at least one keyword that you bring to the discussion.
- *Allusive*: Refer to a key passage or term from the texts you are discussing.
- *Doubled*: Combine your straightforward and allusive titles.
